

Need Help With Your On-Time Shipping Performance?

iCARaS Shipment Compliance will assist you in evaluating your on time delivery performance by tracking shipments and comparing them to your shipping requirements. Once in place, this module will identify whether a given shipment is On-Time, Late, Early, or Missed so the appropriate corrective action can be taken. A variety of user definable parameters provide the flexibility necessary to tailor the system to your business process. Consistent use of this powerful new functionality will help you comply with QS-9002 Requirements, improve your supplier rating, reduce the need to expedite shipments and increase overall customer satisfaction.

Simple, One-Time Setups

- A simple checkbox enables Shipment Compliance Tracking
- Tracking can be controlled at the trading partner, destination, and part level
- Specify a tolerance that states what percentage of the required quantity must be shipped to be considered on-time
- Specify a negotiated Promise Date for a given shipment
- Summarized and detailed reporting
- Optionally exclude certain parts from shipment compliance tracking
- Ability to interface with the Business Activity Monitor (BAM)

Reason Codes

Being able to track why a given shipment was missed is just as important as knowing that it was missed. Once a given shipment has been investigated, users have the ability to assign a compliance code (reason code) to the shipment to identify why the shipment was late, missed or early. The reason codes are user-definable and can be included when printing the shipment compliance reports.

Promise Date

Sometimes it is not possible to meet the required ship date and a negotiated ship date is agreed upon. For that reason, users can optionally enter a "promise date" for a given requirement, within Release Entry, to indicate that parts will be shipped by the agreed upon date. When a promise date is used, shipments that would normally be considered as "missed" or "late", will now display as "On Time" on the Shipment Compliance Report, as long as they meet the promise date. The "promise date" displays as the Expected Ship Date.

Informative Shipment Compliance Reports

The Shipment Compliance Report is available in a detailed or summarized format. The summarized report provides summary information, and will show the percentage of On Time shipments. The detailed report will provide shipment compliance details and it has a variety of criteria that can be used to filter the data to the desired content. The reports can be printed manually as desired, or automatically by defining an iCARaS Scheduler job. Jobs or events can be reported to the Business Activity Monitor as well.

Lots of Criteria to Filter Data

- Include shipment details on report
- Exclude certain parts from report
- Print only shipment compliance exceptions
- Use expected ship times as well as dates
- Use promise date, if applicable
- Generate shipment compliance events within the Business Activity Monitor (BAM)
